### Look Who's Been Sent to the Office

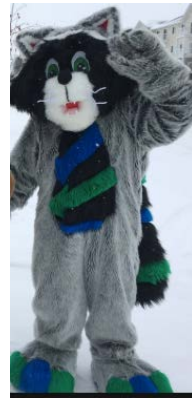


Channing Cyr, Maya McKinnon, Zachary Moore, Ava Weiss were sent to the office in January to show off their great work!

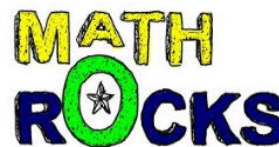
